BOJNIK	<b>Construction of utility infrastructure in the Agro-Business Zone in Kosačić</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 1,000,000</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 218,000</b>	The construction of a new agro-business zone infrastructure in Kosačić, including the construction of the access road, water supply, sewage, power supply and telecommunication infrastructure should create conditions for attracting investments and developing new businesses, increase current agricultural production and result in new jobs for the municipal residents who are predominately engaged in agriculture.
2.	KRAGUJEVAC	<b>Revitalisation and expansion of the brownfield site in the old industrial zone in Kragujevac</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 633,234</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 126,426</b>	Construction of the utility infrastructure and transportation routes to connect the old and new locations in the industrial area with the motorway is of crucial importance for existing and potential investors. Additionally, residents of the nearby settlement Ilina Voda will directly benefit as their households will be connected to the new water supply pipeline.
3.	PARAĆIN	<b>Improvement of economic infrastructure in the industrial zone Zmič</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 299,625</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 52,875</b>	The construction of the access road, sewage network and the street lighting in the new section of the zone will improve the conditions of doing business for the existing as well as for the new investors and enable new jobs, thus improving the overall quality of life and living standards for the Paraćin population.
4.	PRIBOJ	<b>Reconstruction of existing and construction of new water supply and hydrant grid in the Free Zone in Priboj</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 281,059</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 60,939</b>	The reconstruction of existing and construction of new water supply and hydrant grid should contribute to the improvement of the economic infrastructure in the Free Zone in Priboj, thus providing adequate conditions for the eight current investors operating in the Zone as well as for new investors, through the provision of stable water supply and fire protection. As a result, the investment and economic potential of Priboj will be increased.
5.	SMEDEREVO	<b>Construction of utility infrastructure (lighting) in the Industrial Park in Smederevo</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 276,090</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 49,442</b>	The project envisages the construction of two new transformer stations that will increase the capacity and enable the stable delivery of electrical power to existing and future businesses operating in the zone. By installing LED lighting, as well as video-surveillance and fire-protection system, the efficient use of energy sources and savings in maintenance costs will be achieved, increasing the attractiveness of the zone and raising the interest of new businesses to invest.
6.	SOKOBANJA	<b>Reconstruction of the water supply system for tourism development</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 748,679</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 132,120</b>	The reconstruction of the drinking water treatment plant "Carina" and the construction of a 2,722m new primary water supply network will increase water quantities, reduce losses and enable stable and continuous water supply during all seasons to citizens, businesses and visitors. Additionally, through the project, the capacities required for connection to the water infrastructure necessary for functioning of hotels will be provided.
7.	SVILAJNAC	<b>Construction of access road and utility infrastructure in the "New Business Zone"</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 200,400</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 35,364</b>	The infrastructure equipment of the Industrial Zone, including the construction of access roads and utility infrastructure (water supply, sewage and power supply), will create conditions for potential investors and support the Svilajnac Municipality to fulfil the obligations towards existing investors regarding the provision of business infrastructure, all of which will consequently lead to new jobs and improved living standard of the population in Svilajnac and the Pomoravski district.
8.	ŠABAC	<b>Construction of utility infrastructure in the North-Western Work Zone</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 710,360</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 154,884</b>	The construction works on 75ha in the North-Western Work Zone will include the building of water supply network, faecal and rain sewage as well as a road connection to the state road Šabac-Sremska Mitrovica. The new infrastructure will directly improve the conditions for working for the existing businesses and increase the attractiveness of the land to potential investors.

UŽICE	<b>Construction of Rain Sewage in the Business Zone in Krčagovo</b>	EU PRO <b>EUR 426,933</b> Local self-government <b>EUR 75,341</b>	Completion of communal infrastructure for drainage of atmospheric water in the Krčagovo business zone should ensure flood protection for the existing companies and improve the conditions for their business operations. At the same time, conditions for new investments in this business zone will be improved and consequently lead to new investments and jobs.
